

General discussion held on leasing of lakeshore on Leech Lake and Nett Lake Reservations and Grand Portage, with Supt. Krause and B. Grannum responding to questions of T.E.C. members.

Resolution # 66-2 from Leech Lake was discussed and was altered to read as (Insert from Resolution 57-67 T.E.C.)

Be it resolved, that if this resolution is adopted on January 14, 1967, that no more land be subject to lease on Leech Lake Reservation until April 15, 1967, and that a plan for this land be presented at the next Regular meeting.)

Mr. Yankee stated since the T.E.C. has been formed it has accomplished nothing for the minority group. When the new organization was proposed they told us we could take care of 600 or 400 acres and it hasn't come out that way. We have a few old people left that don't want to move or be relocated. They like to live on the lake like the white people. Get our young people started in something. Israel got started, may be we can.

Bernard Martin brought up the problems of hot lunch, clearing of right of way in Rice Lake Area and the unfairness of the  $\frac{1}{2}$  degree clause in our Constitution and By Laws.

Motion by Bernard Martin to have Superintendent Krause contact Roads Department on rights of way, also a discussion on hot lunch. Seconded by Simon Howard. - Carried.
