OLD BUSINESS:

Constitution Alliance- place on hold and continue to write ByLaws.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Rules and Voting issues brought up and will be addressed at May 2023 Delegation Convention.
- 2. Discussion about the governing structure of Mille Lacs. Michae and Julie gave a summary of the system. It is very similar to the U.S. Government in that it has three branches of Government, Executive, Legislative, and Judicial.
- 3. Discussed how to blend the Constitution alliance and the individual Constitutions. Individual Constitutions can not conflict with the policies of the Constitution Alliance. Need a Strong Supreme Court to Iron out differences between the two when there is a conflict.
- 4. A question arose about having a provision in the Constitution Alliance to allow a Band to walk away from the Constitution Alliance.
- 5. The provision in the current MCT Constitution is weak regarding the consultation between the State Government and the Tribes. The language should be "Shall" consult with the tribes.
- 6. Next Directions for the drafting Committee to take:
 - Review the 1936 MCT Constitution to see how the councils were organized and how the TEC came about, how the representatives selection, and the attempts to keep traditions alive
 - Start with the Grand Council Fire next week.
